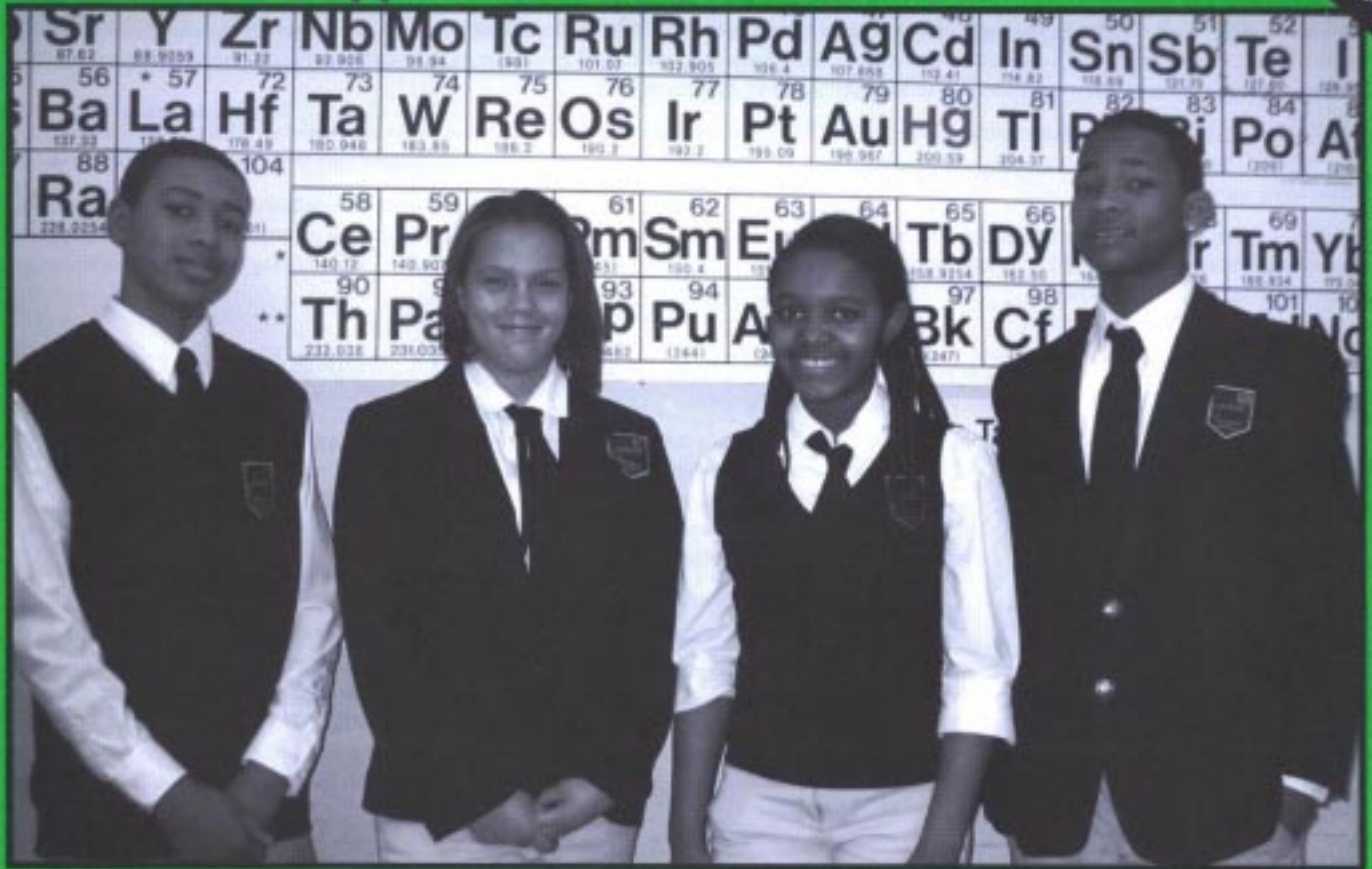

Campus Overview

The Afrikan Centered Collegium Campus (ACECC) uses a culturally relevant approach, for scholars to develop leadership skills, social responsibility and personal life skills. The lower, middle and upper campus is an accelerated environment with high academic standards. Our program uses a rigorous curriculum ranging from PreK-11th grade, which emphasizes college prep, world languages, and cultural foundations of drumming, art, drama, music, theater and dance. We have learning academies and social clubs, as well as opportunities to study abroad.

ACECC offers a safe learning environment with separate bell schedules, transportation, and buildings for elementary and secondary scholars. Campus scholars must adhere to high expectations, strict rules, and academic rigor. All scholars and parents must participate in a mandatory interview process and orientation before being enrolled.

Scholars attending the ACECC upper campus have the distinct opportunity of participating in our Early College High School program. The ECHS is designed to allow scholars to earn up to 60 hours of college credit or an Associate's Degree, at no cost to their parents/guardians, while earning their high school diploma all as part of their ACECC experience.

Afrikan Centered Collegium Campus Standards

Academic Standard of Learning

ACECC scholars must maintain a 2.5 cumulative grade point average in overall classes and coursework. If the standard is not met, a mandatory parent conference will be required. Additionally, the scholar will be placed on an academic probation for one semester to monitor and assure that the standard is maintained. If the scholar does not show any improvement, he/she will be demitted. If a scholar is demitted, he/she cannot return to ACECC for one school year.

Social Standard of School Conduct

ACECC scholars can not receive more than twenty demerits, within an academic year that involves any school conference cards or violations of the district's code of conduct. If the standard is not met, a mandatory parent conference will be required. Additionally, the scholar will be placed on an academic probation for one year to monitor and assure that the standard is maintained. If the Scholar does not show any improvement, or receives more than forty demerits, he/she will be demitted. If a scholar is demitted, he/she cannot return to ACECC for one school year.
