

ACECC Uniform Policy AT A GLANCE

“Dress For Excellence”

ACECC believes that if scholars DRESS for SUCCESS, they will be motivated for academic excellence. We want “our” scholar’s academic experience at ACECC to be life changing. Scholars are considered a reflection of their parents, school and community. Pride in personal appearance is a common value system that we all share. DRESSING for Excellence will be one of our school-wide improvement goals.

1. ALL SCHOLARS (Pre K-11) ARE EXPECTED TO WEAR THE SCHOOL UNIFORM DAILY.
2. Pre-K-2nd burgundy vest, white polo top, blue bottoms; 3rd -5th blue vest, white polo, blue bottom; 6th -8th black vest white button down top, khaki bottoms; 9th-11th khaki vest, white button down top, black bottom, black blazer; 6th-11th grade girls also wear black cross ties and 6th -11th grade boys black dress ties. May 1st-Oct. 1st all scholars are on the “uniform heat release” schedule. During this time scholars may wear polo’s/w logo and appropriate bottoms. 6th -11th grade scholars may only wear polo’s during heat release; Button down shirts must be worn at all other times.
 - Shirts, pants, skirts, and shorts should be clean and pressed.
 - Shirts should be proper length to remain tucked into pants, shorts, or skirts at all times.
 - Solid white or black undershirts may be worn under the uniform shirt or blouse.
 - Pre-K-5th grade girl’s hosiery should be navy blue, black or solid white; 6th -11th grade young ladies hosiery should be white, black, or brown.
 - All Pre-K-5 scholar’s shoes and belts should be solid navy blue, brown, white or black; 6th-11th grade scholar’s shoes should be solid white, black, or brown; belts should be black or brown.
 - Girl’s hair/earring accessories may be red, black, yellow, green, white, navy, burgundy, or brown. Gold, silver and/or diamond earrings may also be worn. Earrings may be no larger than 1.5 inches in length.
 - All scholars may wear a watch.
3. THE FOLLOWING RESTRICTIONS WILL BE ADHERED TO REGARDING UNIFORMS:
 - ◆ NO sagging is allowed at ACECC.
 - ◆ NO spaghetti straps, low cut, tank or halter-tops, or tops that expose the stomach are allowed at ACECC.
 - ◆ NO splits that may expose the thigh or shorts that are more than 2’ inches above the knee may be worn at ACECC.
 - ◆ NO writing, prints, designs, or any additional colors may be worn on any part of the uniform at ACECC.
 - ◆ NO leggings or Capri pants may be worn at ACECC.
 - ◆ NO flip-flops or house shoes shall be worn at ACECC.
 - ◆ NO bracelets, necklaces, or large belt buckles may be worn at ACECC.
4. VIOLATIONS OF UNIFORM POLICY WILL RESULT IN THE FOLLOWING ACTION:
 - FIRST TIME OFFENSE: Parents/guardian called, warning letter sent to parent/guardian.
 - SECOND OFFENSE: Letter sent to parents/guardian and 5 demerits will be given to the scholar. Each day the scholar is out of uniform demerits will be given; they may miss fieldtrip opportunities and/or other special activities).
 - THIRD OFFENSE: Parent(s) and scholar will be required to have a conference with SITE ADMINISTRATOR OR DESIGNEE and the scholar may be placed on probation.
