

VOCAL MUSIC AUDITION

1. Vocal Solos: The student must present two contrasting selections. Contrasting means that if one song is a gospel song, the other must be a show tune, folk song or a classical piece. It does not mean one is a fast R&B and The other is a slow R&B.

A piano accompanist will be provided, no prerecorded tapes will be allowed.

NOTE: BOTH SONGS MUST BE MEMORIZED WITH SHEET MUSIC FOR THE ACCOMPANMIST PROVIDED BY THE STUDENT. FAILURE TO COMPLETE REQUIREMENTS RESULTS IN AN INCOMPLETE AUDITION AND WILL NEED TO BE RESCHEDULED.

2. Sight Reading: The student will sing a vocal line of at least four measures on sight.
3. Rhythm: The student will count out loud a four-measure rhythm "tah". The exercise will consist of eighth, quarter, half and whole notes.
4. Tonal Memory: The student will be given random pitches or tones and will be asked to repeat those tones.
